Art Competition: Awards

The “Kansans... As Talented As You Think!” competition is a juried competition in which jurors will select works based on their talent and artistic ability. One winner from each category will be awarded a \$100.00 scholarship and the Best of Show, chosen from among all the categories will receive a \$300.00 scholarship. Kansas Native Sons and Daughters will host an awards ceremony at their annual Kansas Day Banquet and will exhibit selected pieces of art from the contest and include information about each of the artists whose works are chosen

Eligibility

The “Kansans... As Talented As You Think!” art competition is open to all artists who are currently in 9th through 12th grades and who presently reside within the State of Kansas.

Deadline for Entries:

Images and entry forms must be e-mailed by **November 11, 2011**.

Entry Specifications:

Artwork must be original and created within the calendar year. Only two-dimensional art will be accepted. Entries may be made in the following categories: Black and White Photography, Color Photography, Digital Imaging, Drawing, Mixed Media, Painting or Pastel. Students may enter no more than one work in each of the seven categories.

Entry Format:

Selection will be made from digital images only. Digital images of the artwork need to be e-mailed to kansasjan29@yahoo.com.

- * **Submission is by DIGITAL FILE ONLY in JPEG format.** Digital files may be generated by scanning or high quality digital photography of the original art. Remember, this is a file from which your entries will be judged.
- * An optimum file size of at least 5Megabytes is suggested as a guideline. The image should be no larger than 1600px by 1600px.
- * For non-digital entries, computer color correcting **ONLY** to accurately represent the original art in color, contrast, saturation, etc. is acceptable.
- * **Files should be full image only.** Artwork should fill the image area of the digital file as completely as possible. Frame, mat, fingers, etc. should not show in the digital image. Make the artwork the center of attention when it is shown for judging.

Entries should be sent by e-mail:

- * Use **YOUR NAME** and title of the artwork as the subject of the e-mail. (John Doe – *Sunflowers*)
- * Please send each entry in a separate e-mail; not multiple entries in one e-mail.
- * In the body of the e-mail, clearly identify the artwork with:

(1) Name of Artist (2) e-mail address of artist or **someone other than instructor**, (3) Artist’s **complete** (with city, state and zip) address, (4) Artist’s Birth date (5) Artist’s home or mobile number, (6) Full name and address (including city, state and zip) of school artist is attending, (7) Art instructor’s full name, (8) Art instructor’s e-mail, (9) Name of artwork, (10) Category of artwork (choose black and white photography, color photography, digital imaging, drawing, mixed media, painting or pastel), (11) Date when art was created, (12) Description of techniques employed (100 words or less), (13) Statement of why the subject of the artwork was chosen for representation (100 words or less).
